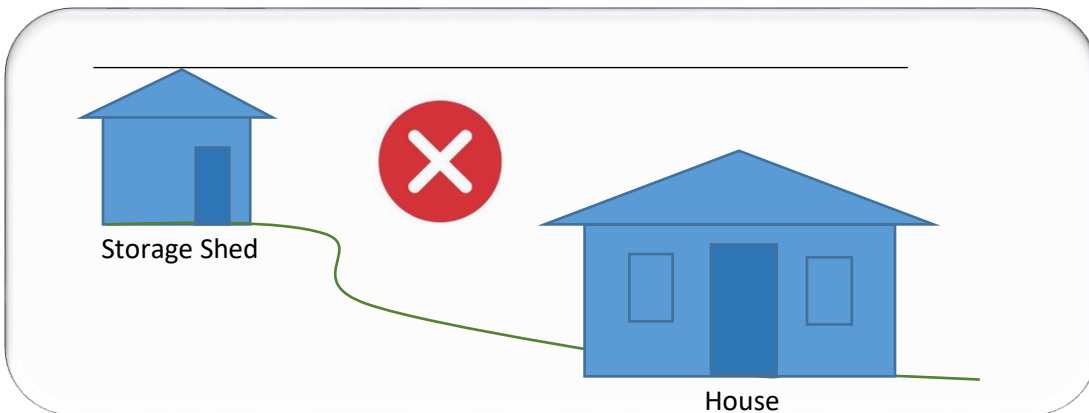
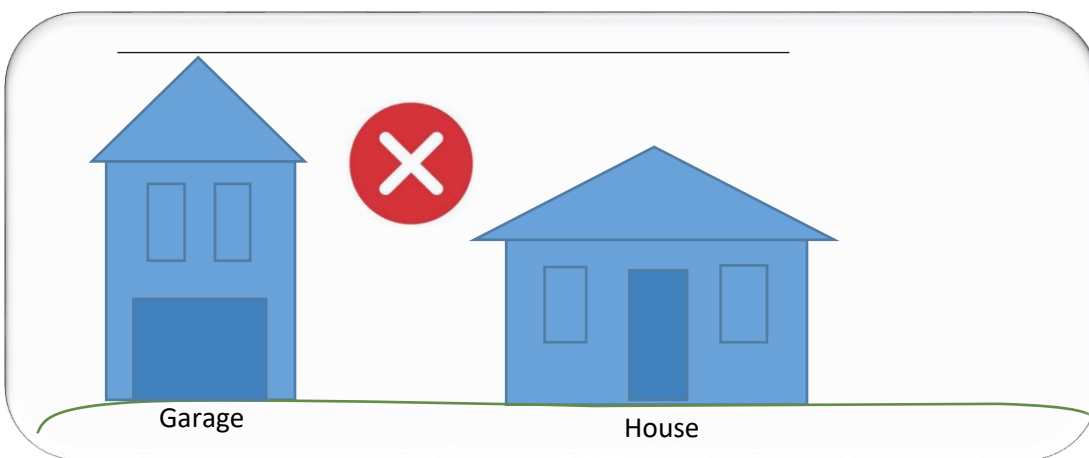


In an agricultural or residential zoning district, the height of an accessory structure shall not extend above the tallest point of the principal structure, unless located in the unincorporated areas of Warren County on a lot containing a minimum of one acre in the AG, RR and R-E zoning districts. Below, are examples showing how an accessory structure may or may not meet this requirement.



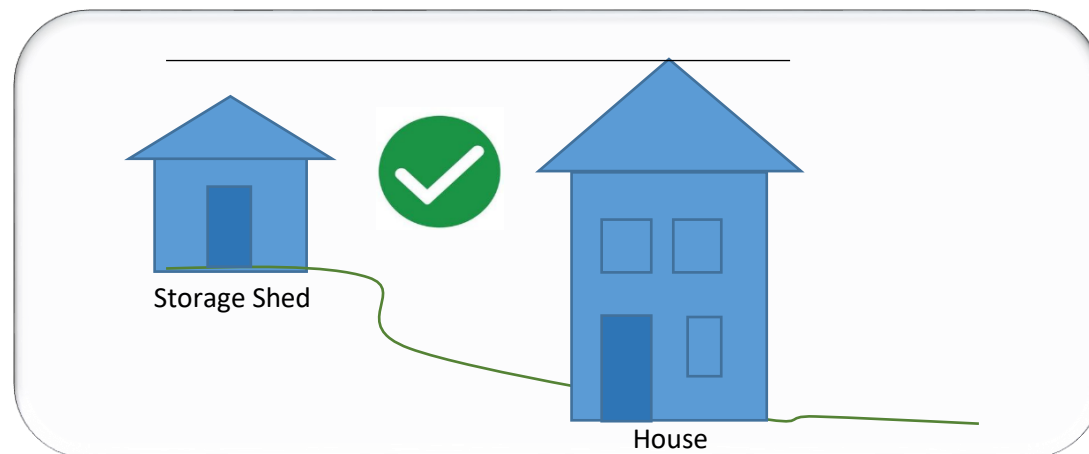
Example 1:

The lot is higher where the storage shed is proposed, and the height of the shed will be above than the tallest point of the house = **Not permitted**



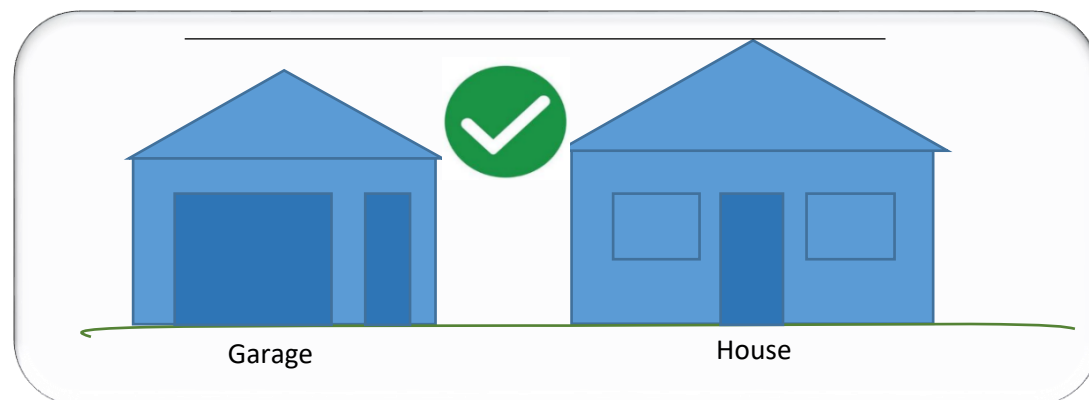
Example 2:

The lot is flat, but the height of the garage will be above than the tallest point of the house = **Not permitted**



Example 3:

The lot is higher where the storage shed is proposed, but the height of the shed will be below the tallest point of the house = **Permitted**



Example 4:

The lot is flat, and the height of the garage will be below than the tallest point of the house = **Permitted**
